

DOCK BOX / LOCKER GUIDELINES

Port-issued triangular fiberglass dock lockers are available for rent; rates are per the Tariff Schedule. Port-issued lockers measure approx. 54" by 34" diagonally. They are 28" deep and store about 14½ cubic feet of material.
Inquire at the Port Office for availability.

The Port also allows store-bought lockers, which must be approved by Port Management.

The Port discourages homemade lockers, but will allow them if approved by Port Management. Homemade lockers should not exceed 14½ cubic feet by more than 10%. A locker that will accommodate fishing poles and skis can be made within these guidelines: 18" x 18" x 77" long.

No locker is allowed on the main walks by order of the Washougal Fire Marshall. Personal lockers should not be wider than half the finger pier, and should be kept as close as possible to the main walk for weight distribution purposes. If the adjoining boater is also using a locker, they should be staggered to allow for easy passage.

All dock lockers will be installed by Port staff. Installation rates are per the Tariff Schedule.

The Marina Manager reserves the right to reject a Tenant-provided locker whether it falls within these guidelines or not.
