RESERVATION PROCEDURE:

Notice: Chairpersons of Events requiring special moorage accommodations or other arrangements must notify the Port at least thirty (30) days before the Event date.

For **annual events**, a minimum six (6) month notice before the Event date is requested. The earlier notice is received, the better the Port will be able to accommodate your Event.

Notice shall also be submitted in writing, i.e., by letter or email, to ensure accurate communication of the Event's / group's requirements.

The following information shall be provided:

- a. Name of Club/Group
- b. Name of Sponsor
- c. Contact Names and Phone Numbers
- d. Email addresses
- e. Description of Event
- f. Requested Date(s) for Event
- g. Number and approx. size of vessels requiring moorage.
- h. Proof of insurance.

Payment: Payment (per the Schedule of Rates & Fees*) is due and payable prior to the Event. Yacht club users may pay for all members participating in the Event with one check, if appropriate.

Insurance: The Port requires "Special Event Insurance" from organizations using Port property for a public or private Event. Please check with the Port Office for details.

Conduct: Fleet captains and/or Event chairpersons are required to maintain close communications with the Port Office and/or Marina Management for all Events. Fleet captains are responsible for the group's compliance with Marina policies and following normal yachting etiquette.
