MARINA & AIRPORT FUEL TRANSACTIONS

How to Avoid a 'Hold' on your Account

We've received numerous calls from pilots and boaters who are surprised to learn there's a 'hold' on a higher dollar amount in their account than the actual cost of fuel purchased. TO AVOID THIS DO NOT SELECT THE 'FILL' KEY. Using 'FILL' will automatically 'hold' \$250 on the card for 24-72 hours -- until the transaction clears and the actual sale amount is posted. [NOTE: The 'hold' is done by the financial institution not the Port.] Instead, select 'Dollars' or 'Gallons' and then estimate the amount needed. As you scroll through the keypad to make your selection, both terminals will display this message:

***PLEASE SELECT FUELING OPTION:
DOLLARS or GALLONS***

FILL-UP KEY--*CAUTION*--\$250 HELD ON CARD FOR UP TO 72 HRS.

Timely Reminder

Marina Tenants Reminder: Please affix your new registration decals to your vessel, and provide a copy to the Port Office. Page 6 of the Marina Policy Manual states: "Moorage Tenants are required to provide copies of current State Registration or Coast Guard documentation as proof of boat ownership." BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES

Protecting the Environment

"Best Management Practices" (BMPs) are low technology ways to protect the environment. As a recipient of the "Clean Marina Award" in 2009, the Port follows these practices and encourages the boating public -tenants and visitors alike - to do the same. One BMP concerns vessel cleaning. There are many nontoxic or less-toxic products available that can be used as alternatives to hazardous household chemicals. Some are commercial preparations, others are common items found at home such as baking soda, vinegar, or soap and hot water for cleaning. A little more "elbow grease" may have to be used with some of these products, but the benefits include improved indoor [i.e. cabin] air quality; less risk of accidental poisoning, and a smaller amount of hazardous material being released into our environment.
