AIRPORT PROJECTS

Improving Grove Field

Taxiway Restriping was just completed at Grove Field when the Port partnered with Camas under the G.E.M (General Equipment & Maintenance) Program to utilize the city-owned hydraulic line-stripping equipment. By using this automated method (rather than the Port's 'walk-behind' painting wheel), the restriping was accomplished in short order to refresh the lines and markers critical to pilots.



A Fuel System Upgrade will be accomplished at Grove Field in the very near future. The plan is to replace the fuel hose and reel, the grounding reel, dispenser, meter, and piping, as well as repainting the front of the tank.

Power Washing the hangar buildings at the Airport in preparation for the upcoming Aviation Career Day event is in progress. (Read more about **Career Day** below.)

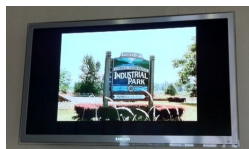
