The media was invited to a pre-open house meeting at 4:30 for an opportunity to meet with Byron Hanke and learn about the Waterfront Advisory Committee's Open House. Reporters from The Columbian and The Post-Record newspapers participated.

The public began arriving shortly before 5:00 p.m. They were greeted at the door and given the following materials (copies attached):

- \* Stations and Boards on Display
- \* Comment Form

Attendees were invited to complete the Comment Form and deposit it in the 'Comments' box after touring the display boards.

Representatives of WAC, MCA Architects, and the Illahee Group arranged twenty 'stations' (easels) beginning in the lobby and continuing into the Meeting Room. Several stations also had blank pads on flip charts to encourage written input. There were easels with display boards incorporating features selected by WAC into different scenarios for public review and comment. In addition, photos, renderings, and information from other waterfront developments were displayed to inform the public of other build-outs. The Port had information about the Marina, Industrial Park and Airfield available to the public.

Estimated attendance was approximately 260. The Comment Forms and flip charts were collected by Arnold to compile into a report for the April 11<sup>th</sup> WAC meeting. The Open House was closed at 8:00 p.m.
