Port of Camas-Washougal Announces Court Date

Washougal, Wash. — November 17, 2009 — The Port of Camas-Washougal today announced that a hearing has been noted on the docket for Friday November 20, 2009 at 9 am before the Honorable John Nichols, Clark County Superior Court judge. The purpose of the hearing is to present the Port's Order Confirming Arbitration Award and Granting Entry of Judgment Against Riverwalk on the Columbia, LLC. This action follows the Interim Award by the JAMS Arbitration Panel dated May 27, 2009 denying all claims made by Riverwalk and declaring the Port the prevailing party in all respects.

The Judgment to be entered confirms an attorney fee and cost award to the Port against Riverwalk in the total amount of \$607,852.67. "We intend to aggressively pursue collection of the award to the Port upon confirmation by the court. This was an action which should never have been brought to begin with and Riverwalk and its members should reimburse the taxpayers for the fees and costs it took to clearly prevail in this action," said Executive Director Dave Ripp.

About the Port of Camas-Washougal

Formed in 1935 by a vote of the local community, the Port of Camas-Washougal features a 400-acre industrial park, a 79-hangar general aviation airport, and a 350-slip pleasure marina. Popular with recreational and general aviation pilots, Grove Field airport also has a state-of-the-art fueling station and 14 tie-downs. The Port of Camas-Washougal marina, largest publicly owned marina on the Washington side of the Columbia River, is adjacent to two restaurants, a launch ramp, hotel, a marina park, fueling station, guest docks, and homeport to the Dolphin Yacht Club. The Port also manages the Parkersville National Historic site and Captain William Clark Park at Cottonwood Beach on the Columbia River.
